Starting January 1st The staff will be "carding" everyone, as you will be required to have your 2025 membership card to be served. If you have not renewed, do it today. Department will be sending out renewal notices in January. I **do not send** out these renewal letters, I have been receiving "not so nice "letters telling me to check my records. I will explain one more time, the Legion dues year goes from, June to June. If you pay your dues before January 1st you are entitled to Lounge privileges, that is a lounge rule, not a post rule. Your 2024 card will allow you to continue to attend meetings, come to the Post (not be served any alcoholic drinks) until May 2024.

The changes are as follows:

Post Constitution and By-Laws: ARTICLE VI – OFFICER DUTIES

<u>SECTION 1</u>: POST COMMANDER'S DUTIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Commander: Will attend not less than three (3) of the 7th District Meetings. If unable to attend he will appoint an active Post member to attend with full authority to act on the Posts behalf.

(Change to) Will appoint an active Post member to attend three (3) of the 7th District Meetings.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: POST FIRST VICE COMMAND-ER'S DUTIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1st Vice Commander: Will attend not less than one (1) of the 7th District Meetings.

(Change to) Will appoint an active Post member to attend one (1) of the 7th District Meetings.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: FINANCE OFFICER DUTIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Finance Officer: Will be an ex-officio member without vote on the Finance Committee.

(Change to) Will be member with voice and vote on the Finance Committee.

Post Lounge Rules:

SECTION 3: LOUNGE BAR SERVERS, WAIT STAFF, AND COOKS WILL BE PAID AS FOLLOWS:

Bar Servers \$9.00 per hour plus Tips to equal the State of Michigan Minimum Wage.

(Change to) \$10.00 per hour plus Tips to equal the State of Michigan minimum wage.

Chapter 4 Riders

ARTICLE III:

SECTION 1

(To be removed and be retroactive for the original By-Laws)

An individual must be a "Regular" paid for one year in order to be eligible to be nominated or hold an elected position.

To comply with National, Department and Post Constitution and By-Laws:

(Replace with) Every member of Chapter 4 ALR, in good standing, will be eligible to hold office.
