I have received the 2026 Membership cards. I am ready to process your renewal as soon as it arrives to me. You must have a 2026 membership card by January 1<sup>st</sup>, or your lounge privileges will be denied. Do not let that happen, be an Early Bird, pay before November 9, 2025.

As always, you can drop or mail your dues to the Post or pay online at michiganlegion.org. It would also be helpful for me if you have a change of address, to please call me or mail the information to the Post.

Another concern is keeping the records current of deceased members. We sometimes only know if a family member notifies us.

Remember that the membership process is a three-step procedure. If you pay your dues

close to the dates listed below, you may still receive another renewal notice, please do not pay again. National is the last to receive notification that you are current. National sends out renewal notices: July 5, Oct 11, Nov.1 2025, Jan.11, March 7, and May 9, 2026. When I question whether I have paid something or not, I look through my records. If you have a 2026 card that is signed by me, you are current. That indicates that you paid. I am still getting members who pay more than once. If you pay multiple times, I will keep the extra payment as a dona-If you have any membership questions, please, call me (not the lounge nor just ask anyone). Attend the general membership meeting, on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of every month at 7pm.

Something that needs to be brought up is "behavior" in the Lounge. If there is a problem in the Lounge, the Bar Server on duty may refuse service for just cause as defined: (loud boisterous, profane or abusive language, drunkenness, disorderly conduct, racial slurs, fighting or verbal assault of others). This will not be tolerated in The Lounge. It can necessitate immediate removal from the Lounge, of the party or parties involved. The party or parties may also be subject to suspension from the Lounge as set forth by the Lounge Committee.

No member shall secure alcoholic beverages for any person who has been refused service or suspended for cause. The Bar Server on duty and the Lounge Committee Members will be responsible for enforcing the rules.

One thing we all have to remember is, this is our home, I'm sure as a member you wouldn't act up in another post and bring discredit to ours.

I would encourage all members to read the Constitution and By-Laws, Standing Rules, Lounge Rules, Son's Constitution and By-Laws, Rider By-Laws.
